The course takes full advantage of the Canadian Shield landscape of mature mixed forests, tall white pines, granite cliffs & rolling hills and valleys. A challenging and scenic course layout for golfer's of all abilities to enjoy. Conveniently located half way between Toronto and Montreal (approximately 2 1/2 hours from Toronto) this course is approximately 30 minutes east of Kingston. It's definitely worth the drive! Glen House Resort is directly across the road from the course & offers a special rate for our tournament. Gourmet waterfront dining at the resorts Shipman's Dinning Room. It also features seven meeting rooms & banquet facilities. High speed Internet rooms, satellite television, indoor & outdoor pools, games room, fitness centre, boat/canoe/kayak rentals. Those who choose to stay at the Glen House receive a round of golf the day before for a highly reduced price. Smuggler's Glen is a five minute drive to the Thousand Island Casino.

Please find enclosed the information pertaining to the event. For returning golfers please note a few changes to our venue. Shotgun start PROMPLY at 12:00 pm. A BBQ lunch is again included.
