Sample Language

Below find sample language for your will or bequest.

Specific, unrestricted:

I give, devise and bequeath to THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION the sum of \$ _____ to be used for any purposes(s) approved by the Board of Directors of the UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION. The receipt of the person who professes to be the Director of Finance or other proper officer for the time being of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION shall be sufficient discharge thereof.

Specific, restricted with escape clause:

I give, devise and bequeath to THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION the sum of \$ _____ to be used for the following purposes(s) _____ . If THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION is unable to apply all or part of these funds for the specific purpose(s) stated herein, the balance of this bequest not so extended may be used for any purpose approved by the Board of Directors of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION. The receipt of the person who professes to be the Director of Finance or other proper officer for the time being of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION shall be sufficient discharge thereof.

General % unrestricted:

I give, devise and bequeath to THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION _____% of the residue of my estate to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION. The receipt of the person who professes to be the Director of Finance or other proper officer for the time being of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION shall be sufficient discharge thereof.

General %, restricted with escape clause:

I give, devise and bequeath to THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION _____% of my estate to be used for the following purpose(s) _____ . If THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION is unable to apply all or part of these funds for the specific purpose(s) stated herein, the balance of this bequest not so extended may be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION. The receipt of the person who professes to be the Director of Finance or other proper officer for the time being of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION shall be sufficient discharge thereof.



Residual contingent trust:

Upon the death of the survivor of my (wife, husband etc.) _____ and my (son, daughter etc.) _____, I direct my trustee to transfer and deliver the balance of the residue of my Estate, including any undistributed income to THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION to be used for any purpose(s) approved by The Board of Directors of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION. The receipt of the person who professes to be the Director of Finance or other proper officer for the time being of THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS KINGSTON FOUNDATION shall be sufficient discharge thereof.
